Roll is also promoting frequent handwashing and personal protection equipment for in-warehouse operations, including mandatory masks. Additionally, users can find information on the personal steps they can take to minimize risk on Roll's website and on the Roll app. As the situation evolves, Roll will continue to adapt our operations by following Ottawa Public Health guidelines.

"Micromobility players have a responsibility to help the safe re-opening of communities," said Richard Cao, CEO of Roll. "Our team is continuously looking at new developments in COVID-19 and developing initiatives to provide an exceptional and safe service to riders."

Roll is also extending its new program, "Heroes Without Capes", to support healthcare workers who are on the frontlines working tirelessly to keep everyone safe and healthy. Healthcare workers can qualify for free 30-minute daily rides and a helmet by downloading the Roll app and registering through the <u>link</u> on Roll's website.
